School conversions from aerial to underground communication feeds:

The Architects and Consultants are requested to specify the placing of “an additional communications 75 mm (3”) or 100 mm (4”) conduit. This could be run with other utilities and should be plugged and terminated at the property line. If Rogers is notified ahead of time, the street portion of the work could be completed as well. The Board’s Plant Department continues to require that “Edwards” fire panels not be listed as an “acceptable supplier” on any new projects. Apparently, Edwards Panels are code protected and we are unable to carry out service and repair.

The Board’s Construction Department continues to advise that (Thyssen Krupp Dover) is not to be listed as an “alternate/acceptable supplier.” (Elevating Devices) due to proprietary maintenance difficulties with this company.

Please make the Gerfloor “Taraflex Multi-use, 5.0 mm thick sheet vinyl as a base bid for elementary school kindergartens and PIP Area – with no alternates. Separate price for 3.0 mm thick sheet vinyl and other manufacturers is NOT required.
