The students of **St. Aloysius Gonzaga Secondary School** in Mississauga, Ontario will be traveling to the Masai Mara region outside **Nairobi, Kenya, Africa** to build schools and work with community children to help make our world a little smaller. This Catholic outreach experience of stewardship and social justice in response to our global community is from April 27 to May 11, 2008.

- **Brick**                    **\$25.00**

- **Block**                    **\$1000.00**

- **Shovel**                    **\$5000.00**

You will receive a shovel with a plaque on it, plus an 8 X 10 picture from the site upon our return with your name on it.

- **Corner Stone**            **\$10,000.00**
