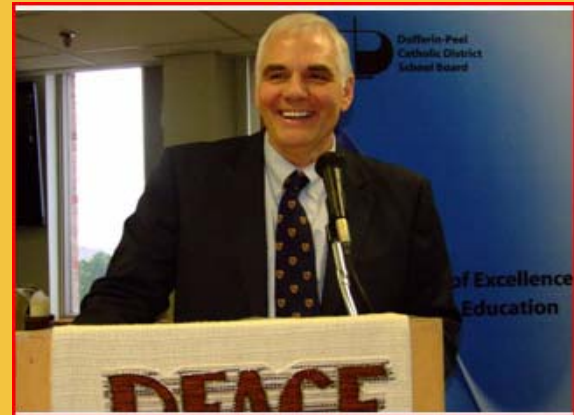
Where did we begin?
