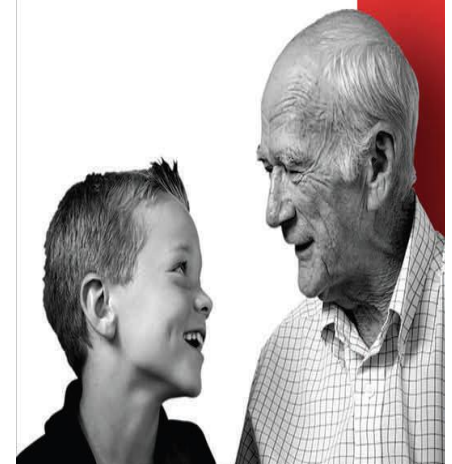

## **Junior and Senior Kindergarten Registration for 2012-13**

Registration for Junior and Senior Kindergarten for the 2012-13 school year, will take place at ALL SAINTS on the following days:

### **Monday, February 6, 2012\***

7:00-9:00 p.m.

\*Snow Date: Tuesday, February 7, 2012 - 7:00-9:00 p.m.

### **Wednesday, Thursday & Friday, February 8, 9 & 10, 2012**

9:00-11:00 a.m.

1:00-3:00 p.m.

Parents/guardians should bring the following documents when registering their child:

- proof of age (Birth Certificate)
- original Roman Catholic baptismal certificate (for child and/or parent/guardian) or baptismal certificate from an Eastern Church in full communion with the Holy See of Rome. If the child has not been baptized, and the parent/guardian is a baptized Roman Catholic or is baptized from an Eastern Church in full communion with the Holy See of Rome, the parent/guardian must bring their own baptismal certificate.
- updated immunization records
- proof of Canadian citizenship (Birth Certificate or Passport) or of Landed Immigrant status
- proof of address (tax bill, utility bill, bank statement)
- for schools in Caledon and Dufferin County: emergency rural address numbers for identifying your property

Junior Kindergarten students must be 4 years of age, and Senior Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age, by December 31, 2012 to register.

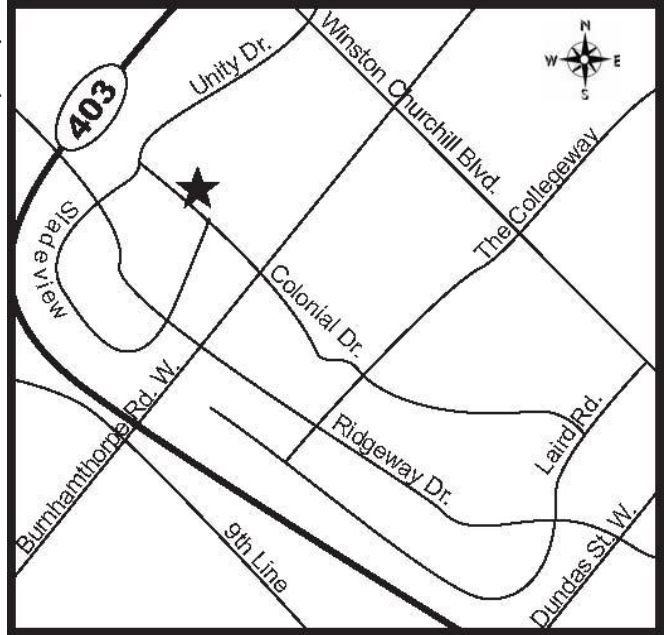
