- To provide students with an individualized program offering opportunities to continue with their education and learn from their mistakes.
- To allow students to re-enter their home schools with dignity, pride and achievement.

### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVES**

- Continue with academic achievement.
- Empower students with increased self-awareness and self-esteem.
- Provide students with opportunity for reconciliation through restorative practices.
- Increase sense of direction.
- Provide social/emotional intervention.
- Increase communication and promote positive relationships between students, parents and the school community.

### INTAKE PROCESS

- Home school will develop a Student Action Plan in consultation with parent(s)/guardian(s) and the student.
- Student on a 6 – 20 suspension can choose to participate in PPC as developed in his/her Student Action Plan.
- PPC teacher will contact the family for an intake meeting.

### PARTICIPATION

- Program expectations are discussed with each student.
- Program is available to elementary and secondary students.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the student and/or parents/guardians.

### RE-ENTRY PROCESS

- Re-entry meeting will be held at home school reviewing achievement in PPC.
- Recommendations for on-going supports will be discussed.
