Spanish, Level 2, Academic

LWSBD

This course provides students with new language learning experiences that will enable them to communicate in the language of study. Through technology-based activities and community-sponsored events, students will continue to explore a range of cultural aspects of the language. Emphasis will be placed on conversation, vocabulary and correct use of language.
