Second Semester Student Registration:

As your students begin second semester please encourage your math departments and the grade 9 and 10 math teachers to encourage and support their students in registering for the Homework Help site. Our goal is to have all grade 9 and 10 students in math this semester registered over the next few weeks. Registration can be done individually however a class registration in the computer lab is also a possibility – it takes just minutes to do!

Many of the teachers surveyed have noted the significance of what the site is able to offer students in terms of individual support outside of the school but have noted that it must be promoted more frequently with students. That’s where your teachers come into play.

TO assist with the registration and promotion piece each of your schools will be receiving a promotional package addressed to the math department head. Each package includes student stickers, flyers (for both the OERB and the Homework Help website), and posters (for the classroom, café, etc...).
