













Liturgical School Year 2010-2011

Saint Matthew was a tax collector called by Jesus to be one of the Twelve Apostles (Mt 9:9). He witnessed the Resurrection and the Ascension. Matthew's symbol as an evangelist is an angel, and is often depicted in art with sword and money bag.
