



WASHROOM AND CLASSROOM SINK ACCESSORIES Elementary & Secondary

The Board has specific types of washroom accessories that are to be supplied and installed on all new projects and additions IN CONTRACT. Soap dispensers, however, are supplied by the Board, but installation is IN CONTRACT.

1.1. GENERAL

- 1.1.1. Grab bars for barrier free washrooms are to be detailed to Municipal requirements.
 - 1.1.1.1. Include grab bars in the Health Sciences Lab (Secondary Schools) for non functioning fixtures.
- 1.1.2. Built-in waste receptacles are not required in any washroom.
- 1.1.3. Barrier free washrooms, PIP washrooms and staff washrooms are to be equipped with paper towel dispensers. Student washrooms are to be equipped with surface mounted electric hand dryers.
- 1.1.4. Material for seats in barrier free showers is to be designed with phenolic slats.
- 1.1.5. Include tracks for shower curtains in the following. (Shower curtains are NIC.)
 - Secondary Schools - Student shower stalls, instructors' and custodians' showers
 - Elementary and Secondary Schools - PIP/Health Room showers
- 1.1.6. Only fully recessed ceramic soap dishes in block walls of showers are acceptable.
- 1.1.7. All mirrors are to be installed with vandal proof screws. Provide hinged mirrors above barrier free lavatories, or vanities.
- 1.1.8. All soap dispensers (supplied by the Board) are to be installed so that soap drips into sink or washfountains

1.2. TEACHING AREAS

- 1.2.1. All teaching areas with sinks are to have a paper towel dispenser and a soap dispenser.
- 1.2.2. Each washfountain in teaching areas is to have two (2) soap dispensers and one (1) paper towel dispenser.

1.3. STAFF AND SERVICE AREAS

- 1.3.1. Each staff area sink is to have a paper towel dispenser and a soap dispenser.
- 1.3.2. Each sink in custodial areas is to have a paper towel dispenser and a soap dispenser.

1.4. WASHROOMS

- 1.4.1. Female staff and all physically challenged and PIP washrooms are to have the following accessories:
 - One (1) toilet paper dispenser and one (1) surface mounted napkin/tampon disposal receptacle for each WC.

One (1) wall mounted napkin/tampon vending unit for general use; one (1) paper towel dispenser, and one (1) soap dispenser.

1.4.2. Male staff washrooms are to have the following accessories:

One (1) toilet paper dispenser for each WC
One (1) paper towel dispenser and one (1) soap dispenser for general use

1.4.3. Female student washrooms are to have the following accessories:

One (1) toilet paper dispenser and one (1) surface mounted napkin/tampon disposal receptacle for each WC.
One (1) wall mounted napkin/tampon vending unit for general use
Two (2) soap dispenser above washfountains
Two (2) hand dryers

1.4.4. Male student washroom are to have the following accessories:

One (1) toilet paper dispenser for each WC
Two (2) soap dispensers above washfountains
Two (2) hand dryers

Preference is for electric HAND dryers Xlerator model XL-W208 Volt. Hair dryers, where required, shall be electric dryers with fixed nozzles @ approximately 1500 mm from fin. floor.

Coat hooks in student or kindergarten washrooms are **NOT** allowed.

Coat hooks are to be installed in Barrier Free washrooms and Staff washroom stalls **ONLY**. (Hooks are to be Bobrick Model # B 2888 or equal.)
