

Safety

Thank you to those parents who are participating in the kiss n' ride program. Your co-operation and understanding, as we try to make improvements, is very much appreciated. The changes you have made in the last couple of months have made a huge difference to both the traffic flow and, most importantly, the safety of all of our children. We would just like to list a few reminders to keep everyone on track:

- if you are driving and need to get out of your car for any reason you should use the parking spaces provided, not the kiss n' ride lane;
- you should pull all the way up to the end of the kiss n' ride lane (or up as far as you are able to) before unloading, and then wait to merge at the end of the lane;
- please do not pull into 'thru lane' from the middle of the kiss n' ride lane, merge at the end of the lane;
- do not, for any reason, drop your children off at the front of the school, this is the bus loading and unloading zone.

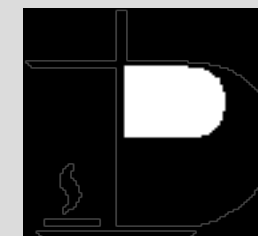

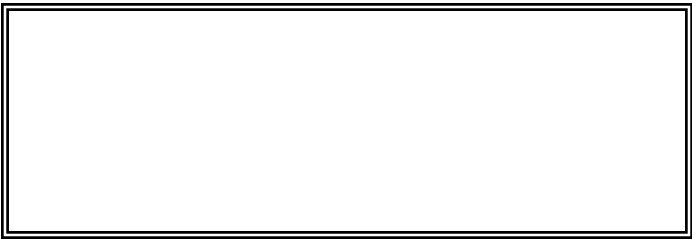
Grade 7 Students attend Diversity Conference
