EQAO Results-- Correction Notice

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The newsletter which was distributed on Friday, November 4th, 2011, incorrectly identified the EQAO results. Please note that the chart below reflects the correct results for 2010- 2011.

Holy Family School has much to be proud of and to celebrate as our achievements in grade three far exceed the provincial and board results and those in grade six exceed the Provincial and Board achievements in both the areas of Reading and Mathematics and are comparable in the area of Writing.

We congratulate our students and teachers in grades 3 and 6 along with all the staff at Holy Family School who work so diligently to ensure that our students are all achieving great academic success.

The Grade 3 and 6, primary and junior division, EQAO assessments measure how well students have met the expectations in *The Ontario Curriculum, Grades 1 - 8*. The assessments test what students know and how well they apply their knowledge and skills in reading, writing and mathematics in everyday situations by requiring students to read and respond to passages, to write and to solve mathematical problems.

EQAO assessments combine performance-based activities, requiring written responses, with multiple-choice questions. The results are reported in terms of achievement from Levels 1 to 4, with level 3 as the standard, which represents a high level of achievement.

The results for Holy Family School, stated as the % of students meeting the Provincial standard (Achieving Levels 3, 4) are as follows for the 2010-2011 assessment.
