The RCGA Foundation encourages the athletic and academic careers of promising Canadian golfers, and students of the industry, by offering financial assistance through scholarships. Our mission is to offer Canadian athletes and sport academics the opportunity to stay in Canada to continue their post-secondary education while continuing to compete and train at a very high level.

Since 1982, the RCGA Foundation has awarded 293 promising young golfers, landscape architects and turfgrass agronomists, a total of 626 scholarships valued at over \$2,103,500.00. This scholarship program is funded through generous donations from corporations, golf clubs, associations and individual friends of golf.

All scholarship applicants must be attending or have been accepted at a Canadian university or college with a golf program recognized by the RCGA Foundation (with the exception of the Geordie Hilton Academic Scholarship). A list of recognized schools can be found on our website.
