

Children in Need of Treatment (CINOT) Program

The Children in Need of Treatment (CINOT) program pays for basic dental treatments for children and youth whose families or guardians cannot afford dental care. In 2009, the age eligibility limit for the CINOT Program that was previously age 13, was increased to age 17.

Children and youth may be eligible for the CINOT program if:

- The child lives in Peel
- The child has a valid Ontario health card
- The child is under 18 years of age
- The parent does not have a private or government dental plan (i.e. Ontario Works, Ontario Disability Support Program) AND
- The cost of going to the dentist is too expensive for the family
