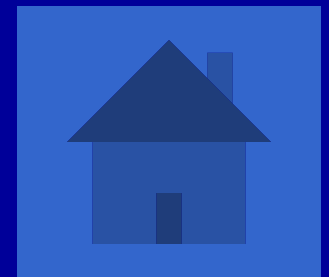

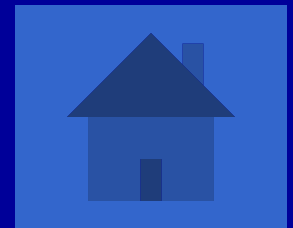
A country which has undergone recent, rapid industrialization. Examples include Hong Kong, South Korea, Brazil and Mexico.
