The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board will hold a public consultation meeting as part of its deliberations for the board's 2010-11 budget.

Parents/guardians and community members are welcome to attend to make a presentation at the meeting or provide written input.

The deadline for registering to make a presentation is May 14.

Each presenter will have a maximum of five minutes to make their presentation.
