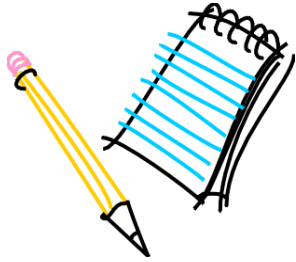


Grade 3 Term 2 Highlights

The Grade 3 EQAO testing will be held during the weeks of May 23- June 6th. Please do not schedule any appointments on these days. Details to follow.

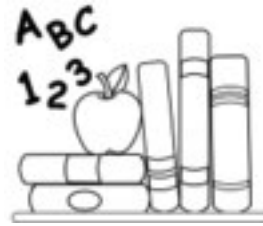
