Subject: Chaplains/Chaplaincy Team Leaders
Effective Date: (359) October 25, 2005

The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board supports one full-time Chaplain or Chaplaincy Team Leader in each secondary school, where deemed reasonable, subject to enrolment considerations.

REGULATIONS

1.76 Chaplains/Chaplaincy Team Leaders

1. Ordained clergy, appointed as full-time Pastoral Care Ministers in Dufferin-Peel, shall be called “Chaplains”.
2. Lay persons, appointed as full-time Pastoral Care Ministers in Dufferin-Peel, shall be called “Chaplaincy Team Leaders”.
3. Duties and responsibilities of all Chaplains/Chaplaincy Team Leaders will be regulated by the Chaplaincy Guidelines, revised and approved May 2005.
4. Qualifications and the posting/hiring process for all Chaplains/Chaplaincy Team Leaders will be regulated by the Chaplaincy Guidelines, revised and approved May 2005 and General Administrative Procedures 302.01.
5. Issues of confidentiality and disclosure concerning all Chaplains/ Chaplaincy Team Leaders, will be regulated by the Chaplaincy Guidelines, approved May 2005.
6. Performance appraisals, reviews and dismissal of Chaplains/ Chaplaincy Team Leaders, who are not members of the teaching profession, will be regulated by Appendix “F” of the Chaplaincy Guidelines, approved May 2005.
