It is the goal of the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board to offer a full range of secondary programs at all levels to all students who attend its schools.

REGULATIONS

2.05 Composite Secondary Schools

To enhance the concept of Christian community, appropriate programs for all students will be offered in the one building in a composite * school setting. The rate of progress towards this ideal will be dictated by the constraints of finance and the availability of accommodation (both general and specialized). In some cases, the existence of a small number of students requiring specialized facilities may necessitate grouping.

* A composite school is understood to be one in which the number and variety of subject courses offered will enable all students to obtain a graduation diploma. In addition, programs will be provided (numbers permitting) in such schools for the mentally and physically handicapped.

The subject courses offered within each program will ensure admittance into post secondary programs at colleges or universities, and provide the basic job entry skills for apprenticeship or employment in business, industry, or sheltered workshops.
