BOARD POLICY / REGULATIONS

Subject:	Smoke-Free Schools
Effective Date:	(295) June 15, 1999

Consistent with the Tobacco Control Act, the policy of our schools is to prohibit smoking and holding lighted tobacco anywhere in the school or on school property, by anyone, at any time.

This policy applies to students, staff and anyone using school properties. The policy also applies to field trips by staff and students, and anyone using the school bus system.

REGULATIONS

6.70.2 Smoke- Free Schools

As a result of any infraction of the Tobacco Control Act, the Board has approved the following additional disciplinary action:

1. After the first occurrence, the Public Health Department may be contacted;
2. After the second occurrence, the Public Health Department may be contacted;
3. After the third occurrence, the Public Health Department must be consulted regarding further legal action.

The school administration will complete the public health documentation supplied by the Public Health Department (Smoking Infraction Form);

The school administration will carry out disciplinary action they see appropriate either in conjunction with the Public Health Department or independently.
