BOARD POLICY / REGULATIONS

Subject:	Admissions – International and Work and Study Permit Students
Effective Date:	April 8, 1991; Revised (297) May 25, 2004; Revised (300) October 28, 2008; (076) January 25, 2011

An International student may be admitted to a school, subject to the availability of program and space and the payment of fees.

A. International Students

The student is a Roman Catholic or Catholic of the Greek or Ukrainian Rites in union with the Holy See of Rome. Secondary students can be admitted under Open Access.

The student must hold a Study Permit from Immigration Canada to undertake a particular program within the Board's jurisdiction.

The Board's Admissions Department must determine that sufficient accommodation is available for the student. Families will be directed to make an appointment at the Newcomer Reception Centre to determine student programming needs.

Continued enrolment in the school will require an annual renewal of fees and study permit.

Application must be received prior to June 15 for admission for the following September. In secondary schools, students will be admitted to Semester Two if their request is received prior to October 15.

B. Work and Study Permit Students

At the elementary level, either the student or parent(s)/guardian(s) must be baptized Roman Catholic or Catholic of the Greek or Ukrainian Rites in union with the Holy See of Rome. At the secondary level, students may be admitted under Open Access.

The student's parent(s)/guardian(s) must hold a valid Work Permit and the student may also hold a study permit from Immigration Canada to undertake a particular program within the Board's jurisdiction. If the family holds both, the Admissions Department would need both permits.

The Board's Admissions Department must determine that an appropriate program and sufficient accommodation are available for the student.

Continued enrolment in the school will require an annual renewal of the work and/or study permit.

Parent(s)/guardian(s) on a work permit or student(s) who accompany parent(s)/guardian(s) on a work or study permit, do not pay fees.
