Dear Parent(s) / Guardian(s):

As a parent/guardian of a child in a Dufferin-Peel Senior Kindergarten classroom, you may wish to consider the French Immersion program as a possibility for Grade 1 in September 2010. French Immersion is a program in which 90% of the Grade 1 instruction is delivered in French. Instruction in English is added in later years.

The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board presently offers the French Immersion program at St. Margaret of Scotland and St. Gertrude in Mississauga, and St. Joachim and Our Lady of Providence in Brampton. Transportation is NOT provided for students. It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to transport their children to and from the French Immersion centre.

This program offers an excellent opportunity for becoming functionally bilingual in later years and has been found to be very successful. Over 300,000 students are enrolled in Extended French or French Immersion annually across Canada.

Students in the Dufferin-Peel French Immersion program attain a high level of proficiency in French at no cost to the student's English proficiency or achievement in other academic subjects, such as science and mathematics. Students in the French Immersion program receive at least 3800 hours of instruction in French by the end of Grade 8 and can:

- communicate effectively in French, by selecting the correct words and nuances, and adapting language in order to be understood;
- understand radio, television, newspapers and books, with the occasional help of a dictionary;
- demonstrate knowledge of the culture, society, customs, economy, government and institutions of a French-speaking community;
- function well in a French-speaking community.

More detailed information will be available at parent/guardian meetings to be held at the two new French Immersion locations. **Please mark the date for the appropriate French Immersion centre on your calendar:**

- **St. Joachim: 7:00 p.m. Monday, January 25, 2010**
- **Our Lady of Providence: 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, January 26, 2010**
- **St. Margaret of Scotland: 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, January 27, 2010**
- **St. Gertrude: 6:30 pm, Thursday, January 28, 2010**

Please note that students residing in Brampton, Caledon, Dufferin County and Malton may access French Immersion at either St. Joachim or Our Lady of Providence French Immersion centres. Students residing in Mississauga (except Malton) may access French Immersion at either St. Margaret of Scotland or St. Gertrude.

Submitting an Application

Completed applications will be accepted at the French Immersion school office *from February 16, 2010 up to a deadline of 2:00 pm on Wednesday March 3, 2010.*


A copy of the application will be given to the parent(s)/guardian(s) at the time of submission. There will be no numbering of applications.

A lottery will be held on a pre-determined and advertised date if, and only if, the number of applications received at the school exceeds the places available.
