Award Specifications:

Field of Study: Faculty of Arts, Commerce or Science
Value: \$2,000.00 per year/ \$8,000.00 total
Number of Awards: One renewable entrance award will be awarded annually.

Terms:

Awarded annually to a graduate of an Ontario Secondary School, who has completed the Specialist High Skills Major program (university stream), and is enrolled at Saint Mary's University as a full-time student (30 credit hours). Student must be enrolled in a program which correlates with their high skills major.

The SHSM Award will be awarded and renewed on satisfactory academic achievement (75% average out of high school and 2.5 GPA in order to renew scholarship) and continued full time enrolment. Students must be enrolled in full time study and maintain a course load per year sufficient to complete their undergraduate degree within four years.

This award is renewable each year of the recipient's four year degree at Saint Mary's permitted they meet the terms outlined above.

Award selection will be determined by Saint Mary's University Recruitment and Admissions Office, and based upon student achievement and leadership demonstrated in their high skills major area (through academic success, work experience and related accreditations).
