Dual Credit Student Success

The passing grade to receive the Dual Credit at Humber is 60%. We hope your students will take advantage of all the resources at Humber to help them be successful. The Dual Credit program is an excellent opportunity for the students to take on new responsibilities and to develop the skills to transition into post secondary education.

Attendance and participation in the classes is crucial to the success of the Dual Credit students. The professors will be discussing attendance protocol with the students and by law we will be sending regular attendance updates to keep you in the loop.
