- 3 newspaper articles (1 Star, 2 Globe),
- 4 web site articles (1 from www.duhaime.org, 1 from www.canadianlawsite.com, 2 from www.acjnet.org)

Note: Although you have found these reports or articles on the web they are not officially web-based.

Not allowed: encyclopedias, Wikipedia, blogs, other non-credible sources

If you cannot find at least six sources of information, then you should consider changing either your topic or your thesis.

<u>Annotations:</u> Do the annotations sufficiently and succinctly summarize and evaluate the source? Is it indicated how the source will be used?	/10	
<u>Citations:</u> Are the citations structured correctly according to the selected style (APA, MLA)? Are there any errors in punctuation placement?	/10	
<u>Sources:</u> Are a sufficient number of academically credible sources used? Are there too many web-based sources?	/10	
<u>Mechanics:</u> Is the piece grammatically sound? Are there any misspellings and/or typos? Are there errors in structure and/or punctuation?	/10
