

DRESS CODE

Each Chapter Advisor **MUST** discuss business attire with their chapter members prior to the Regionals.

- Sneakers
- Black running shoes
- Work boots
- Open toed shoes
- Sandals or flip-flop sandals
- Denim jeans of any colour
- White socks (sport socks)
- Bare legs (without pantyhose)
- Very short skirts or mini skirts
- Hats
- Sunglasses

Females

- Blazer/business suit with dress blouse or skirt or dress slacks with dress blouse or dress sweater or business dress with stockings
- Skirt (½ " above knee) or dress
- Dress shoes
- Hair off the face

Males

- Business suit with collared dress shirt and necktie or
- Sport coat/dress slacks, collared shirt and necktie
- Dark coloured socks
- Dark coloured business shoes

Wearing a blazer or jacket, for both males and females, is recommended, but is strictly optional.

Students will NOT be permitted to wear school uniforms at the Regionals Competition.

This includes school-crested

blazers or shirts; ANY clothing that may identify your school will NOT be permitted.

For competition purposes during the

Orals only, DECA blazer will NOT be allowed.

It should be understood that all "**appropriate business attire**" is clean and pressed.

- Use of abusive or profane language
- Defacing of public property; vandalism
- Verbal or physical harassment
- Smoking on school property
- Substance abuse (drugs, alcohol, etc.)
- Inappropriate assembly behaviour in either Opening or Closing Ceremonies; on stage or off
- Cheating or plagiarism
- The dress code will be in effect during competition hours**

We hope that this clarifies the code of conduct and dress code, and all students and advisors will adhere to the code at the Regional Competition.
