PERIOD 2 SOAP DRIVE CHALLENGE

For the 2009/2010 school year SJA Student Council has decided to focus our charitable efforts in helping and supporting Dr. Simone and his Canadian Food for Children (CFFC).

Rationale:

Soap is a simple part of our daily lives, but many do not have access to soap. Washing one's hands with soap, according to the United Nations World Health Organization, is the most effective and inexpensive way to prevent disease and infection. Every year over 2 million children around the world (under the age of 5) die in developing countries from diarrhea, pneumonia and various infections. More than half of these deaths could be prevented if people were provided with soap to wash their hands.

We strongly believe that our commitment in helping Dr. Simone and The Canadian Food for Children through this campaign will help save lives!

OUR GOAL: To collect 10,000 bars of soap

OUR CHALLENGE:

Student Council is challenging all period 2 classes to collect as many bars of soap as possible. Remember! The more bars of soap we can donate to Dr. Simone, the more lives we can save in the world.

Student Council will match the combined total of soap bars brought in by the entire student body. (Example: If all the students/teachers of period 2 bring in 10,000 bars of soap, we will donate an additional 10,000 more....)
