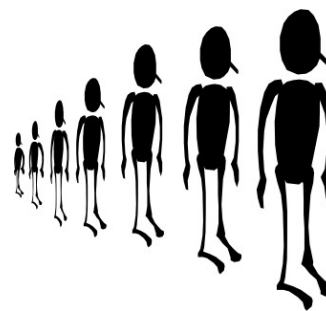


Ways to Expand and Enhance Your Educational Experience
