Select one of the following topics:

1. The Depression—life in the 1930s.
2. Life after the Civil War—1865-1900
3. Japanese Canadians/Americans during WW2
4. Racist Trials of the 20th Century—Emmett Till,
5. The Alabama Bus Boycott—the Rosa Parks story.
6. Harper Lee, Francis Finch Lee and Truman Capote
7. Anti-semitism in the 20th Century
8. Klu Klux Klan
9. Civil Rights Years
10. Aboriginal History in Canada.

Method

- (i) Select one of the above topics. In groups of THREE, prepare a presentation where you teach the class the most important and interesting aspects of your topic to the rest of the class.
- (ii) If possible, try to relate your research to what you have learned from *To Kill a Mockingbird*.
- (iii) You must use some form of Audio-Visual Aids—power-point, slides, movie clips etc. to enhance your presentation
- (iv) Your seminar should be 15-20 minutes and each individual should speak for 4-5 minutes.
- (v) Each person is given an individual mark. Be prepared to present whether or not the other members of your group are present.
- (vi) You are responsible for securing all equipment needed for your presentation.
