

Sample Student Timetable

As you make your transition from grade 8 to grade 9, you may feel overwhelmed by the many decisions ahead of you. This Compass Orientation Booklet was designed with your needs in mind. If you still feel overwhelmed and need further support, the Guidance and Career Education Department at your school will assist you in making sound decisions for your future.

The Semester System:

The school year is divided into two equal parts and you are required to complete half of your program each semester. The first semester is from September to January and the second semester is from February to June. You will take four credits each semester.

How to Read Your Timetable:

The school year is organized in either a semester system which has two terms or a full year system. Both systems will give you the same amount of credits at the end.

In some schools, homeroom period is period one. This period may be slightly longer

Length of Period: 75 minutes (approximately) with travel

Lunch: In some schools, students have the same lunch. In other schools, there are two or more designated lunch times. Students attend class during the other two periods.

3A – 10:55 – 11:35
3B – 11:40 – 12:20
3C – 12:25 – 1:05
