- They are trying to be more proactive
- Kindree school issues - it's been brought up with school board. The bell time change was not approved by STOPR - wasn't proceeded properly

- Trustee Corbet expressed that our school should not being affected by a non-approval change
- They will assess traffic in the area
- There is resistance of change because its already been communicated to their school
- Things are on a hold right now
