| Library | <p>Join us in the library from November 1st to November 9th for a special exhibition of World War 1 artifacts, courtesy of the Canadian War Museum.</p> <p>Every day we will highlight one artifact in the collection, and today those are Puttees. Puttees are strips of cloth, which were worn wrapped around the lower leg in a spiral pattern, from the ankle up to below the knee. They provide ankle support and prevent debris and water from entering the boots or pants. Khaki-coloured wool puttees were widely worn with ankle boots by British Empire soldiers during the First World War.</p> <p>Stop by the library to try wrapping puttees yourselves!</p> |
