IMPORTANT DPCDSB SECONDARY SUMMER SCHOOL GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS: Students who are currently enrolled in a Secondary School program are eligible for admission to the Summer School Program and must apply directly through their guidance office.

The student must have the required prerequisite and the Principal/Designate has approved the application.

Grade 8 students entering Grade 9 in September 2020 are not eligible to take Summer School courses.

CODE OF CONDUCT: The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board, Adult and Continuing Education Department will strive to create a Catholic learning community in which students are able to develop their spiritual, intellectual, physical and social potential. ATTENDANCE:

- Students must attend class on the first day of Summer School or will be withdrawn from the course.
- Regular attendance is crucial for success in all credit programs. Attendance and punctuality are compulsory.
- Students will be demitted after 3 (three) consecutive absences.
- Students may be demitted following a contravention of the Catholic Code of Conduct.

TEXTBOOKS: A \$90.00 deposit must be submitted on the FIRST DAY OF CLASS. This will be refunded upon the return of an undamaged book. *Cheques or Money Order* should be made payable to Dufferin-Peel CDSB. Visa/Mastercard is also accepted and payment slips available.

CRASP (CREDIT RECOVERY ALTERNATIVE SUMMER PROGRAM)

- Students who failed a course with a mark of **40-49%** have an opportunity to earn credit under this program. Students may sign up for sessions that will run **July 6 to 17 or July 20 to 31, 2020**.
- Students who failed a course with a mark of **0-39%** can earn the credit by registering for the 4-week summer course from **July 6 to July 31, 2020**.
- Ensure that the conditions outlined above are met when you sign off on the registration forms. Marks will be double-checked.

UPGRADING MARKS

- Students upgrading marks need to register for the 4-week summer course from **July 6 to July 31, 2020**.
- Please ensure that the conditions outlined above are met when you sign off on the registration forms. Marks will be double-checked.

FINAL EXAM: Students must write an examination at the end of the program, on the date and time set out by the Adult and Continuing Education Department. Note the exam dates below. **Students who miss the scheduled final exam will receive a mark of zero for the exam**
