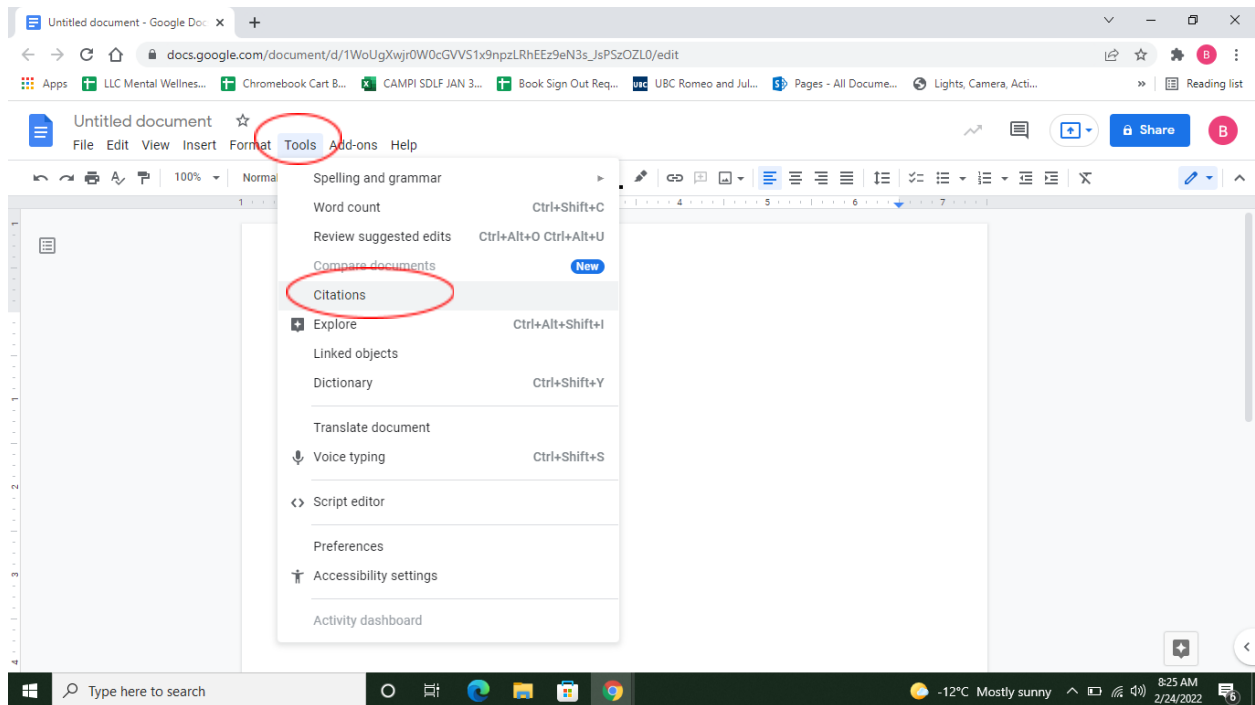
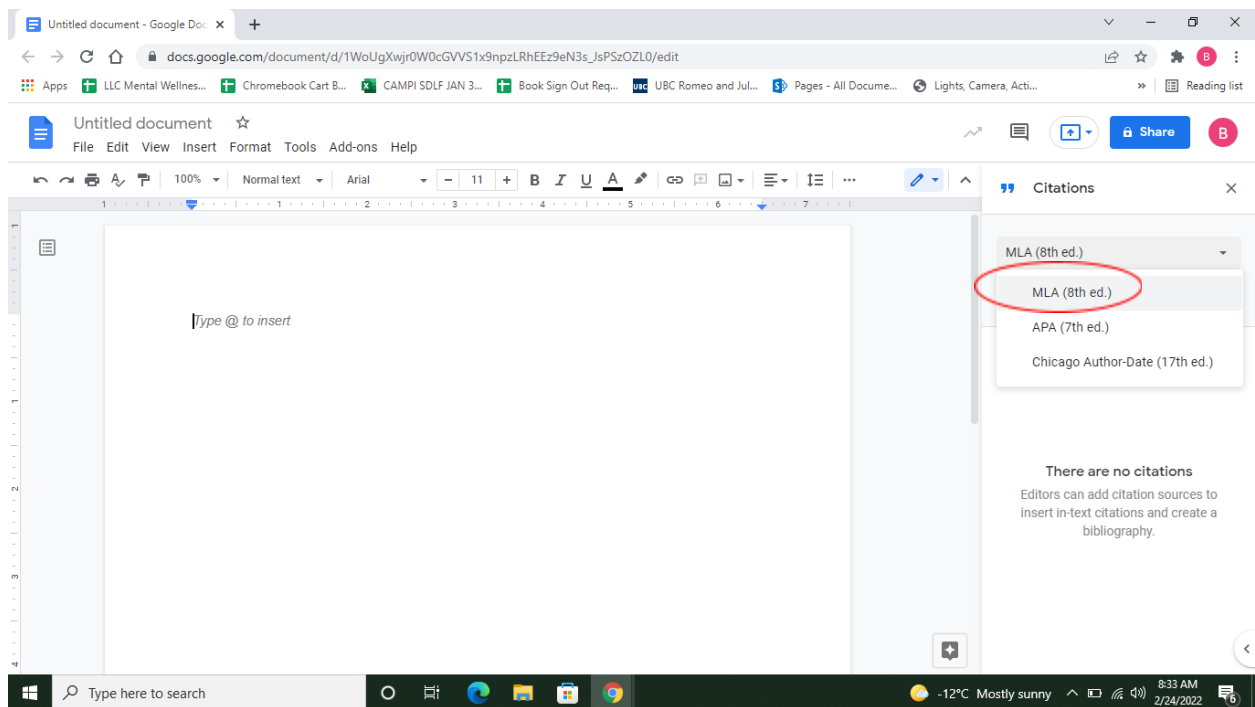


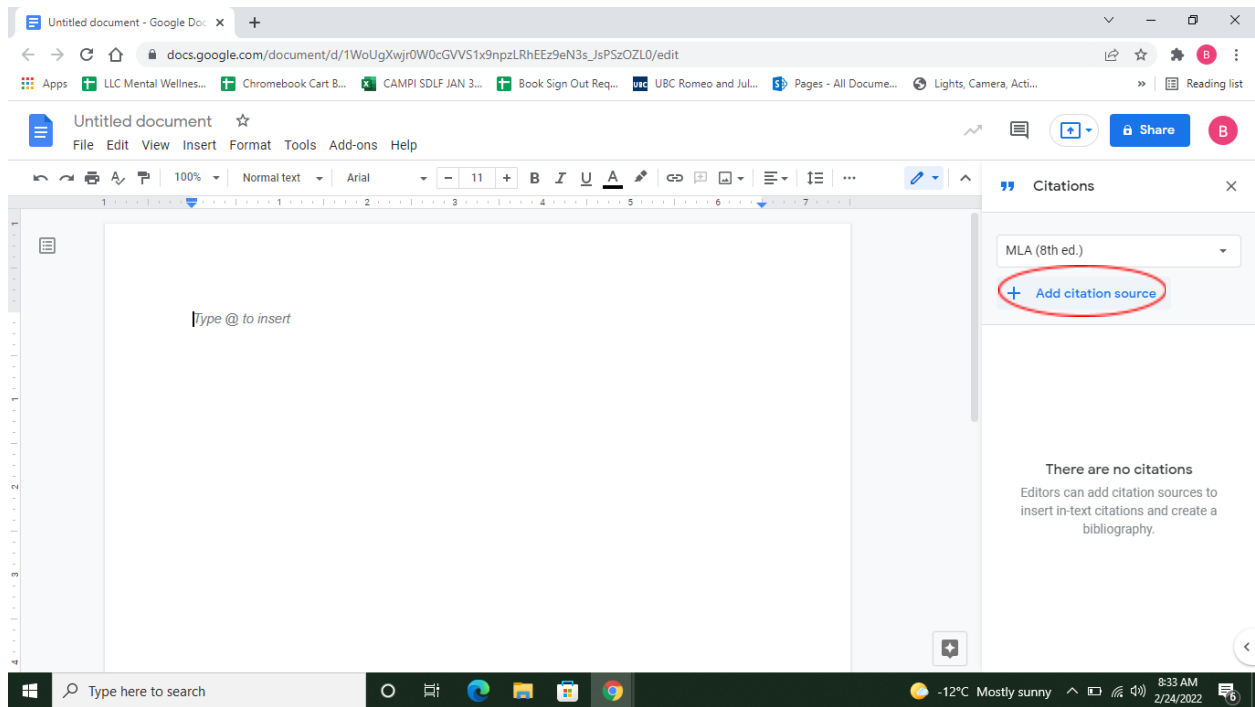
## Step 1: Click Tools > Citations



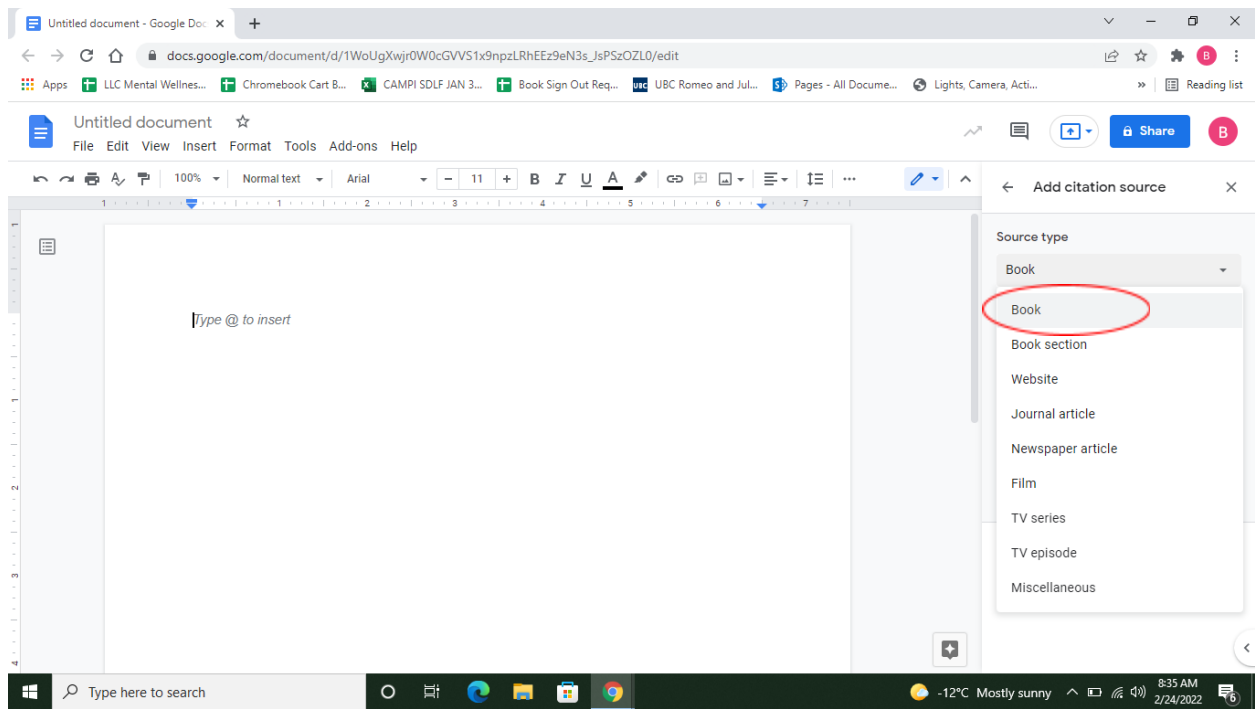
## Step 2: Select MLA (8th Edition) from the drop-down menu on the right side

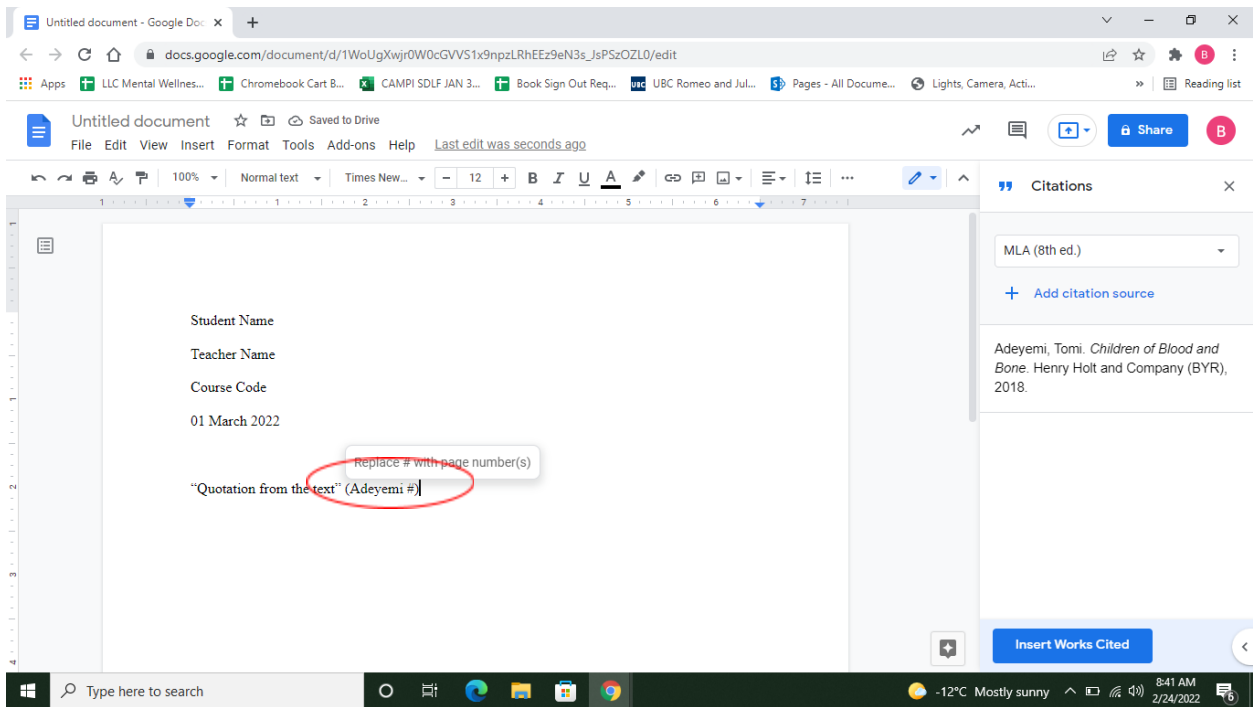
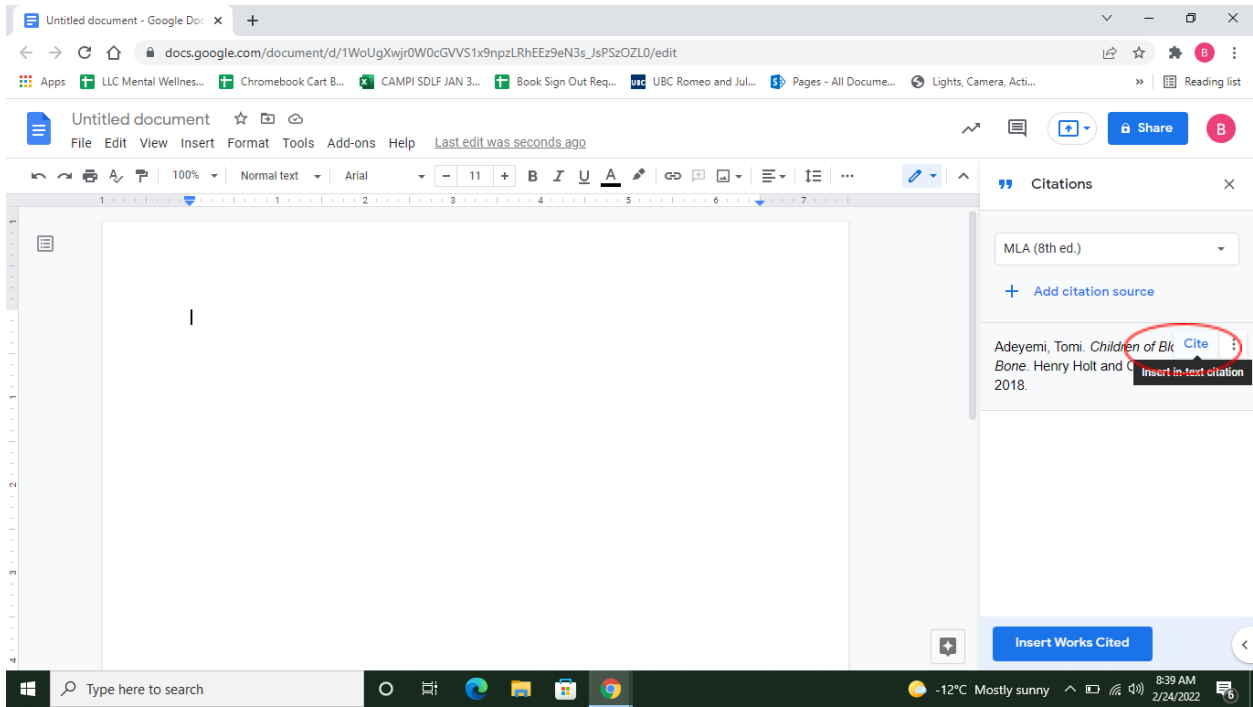
