- Black shoes (closed toe, closed heel – no slippers, slides or crocs)
- McCarthy's navy blue pants (Grade 9, 10) or khaki pants (Grade 11, 12) with the St Edmund Campion logo
- McCarthy's short sleeve or long sleeve navy golf shirt with the St Edmund Campion logo
- During colder conditions: McCarthy's navy sweater with the St Edmund Campion logo (McCarthy's golf shirt must be worn underneath)
- Spirit Wear may only be worn on scheduled "Spirit Wear Days" and is NOT permitted as part of the school uniform.

### **Communication Procedure for Accident/Injury**

Injured students are brought to the main office (if possible) or a call is made to alert that First Aid support is required

- First Aid is administered as necessary on a case-by-case basis.
- Parents/Guardians are informed in priority sequence according to contacts on file.
- If a parent/guardian is unreachable, a phone call will be made to the emergency contact.
- Should the injury require further attention beyond general First Aid, 911 will be called and a parent/guardian will also be notified.
- Injury is reported and logged in the main office.
