"EVIDENCE-BASED" DOES NOT ALWAYS MEAN THE EVIDENCE COMES FROM GOOD RESEARCH

The term "evidence-based" refers to the quality of the scientific evidence to show that an intervention works the way it is supposed to. Just because the study is published in a journal or posted online, it does not mean that there is strong evidence that the intervention works.
