C. Presentation – M. Biagi on MyBlueprint

- Handed out *Getting Started Guide for Parents*
- MyBlueprint is for students JK to grade 12. JK to grade 6 it is called **All About Me**. Grade 7 to 12 it is a student e-portfolio called the **Education Planner**. It is a mobile-friendly education and career/life planning resource accessed by students, parents, counsellors and teachers in thousands of schools to help students build an Individual Pathways Plan (IPP) and engage them in planning for their future.
- Students can complete multiple career assessments, unlock occupation matches, plan their courses, compare post-secondary programs, build resumes, cover letters, budgets, and portfolios, etc.
- Parents can access a parent account, link with your child, and view a live feed of their child's Education Planner activity. Access to parent monthly newsletter is available on the board website www.dpccsb.org
- The tool is private, personal, not graded and is available to students through their OEN/Ontario Education Number, which remains with the student through post-secondary.

- Guided by and allows for all Ontario Catholic School Graduate Expectations
- Dufferin-Peel is the only Board that includes a faith section i.e. add a prayer, reflection on sacraments, investigate faith based careers

 - Handed out *CMHA Peel Quick guide to mental health resources* and Peel Service Collaborative Pocket Guide. Mental Health Team is working on the board MH strategy

 - “*Journey into Learning*” parent/child open houses will be occurring at all elementary schools beginning in April 2018. These events were previously known as the “Welcome to Kindergarten” nights. Curriculum related materials will be available for students to receive during the *Journey Into Learning* evening. Schools are responsible for the cost of these bags. Schools / principals will determine if they would like to purchase these or create their own.
