1. Trustee Report – S. Pascucci

 - An additional French Immersion Program at Philip Pocock Secondary School is being considered.
 - Momo Challenge communication was provided to parents. The information bulletin will be shared with the committee.
 - i) Responding to D. Langley, Trustee S. Pascucci clarified that the School Messenger text message that went out to elementary parents was sent in error, and that the system used the contact numbers provided when students were registered. Communication will be provided to elementary parents before the release of this attendance system.
 - ii) Responding to D. Langley, Superintendent W. Brunton clarified that an image release form should be sent for images posted on Twitter or school websites.
 - iii) S. Gos clarified that the Momo Challenge community information bulletin is on the front page of the Board website.
2. Superintendent Report – W. Brunton
 - At Faith and Program an excellent resource called ‘Praying as a Family’ was shared and will be provided to all CCCSC members next month.
 - As a follow up to our cannabis letter, a new policy was put forward, Policy 26.00.
 - At our next meeting we will select three CCCSC representatives to review and select the Volunteer of the Year. The selection team will meet before our May CCCSC meeting.
 - The Volunteer of the Year Award application process will be sent to principals mid-March and will be due by April 30.
 - Superintendent S. Gos is organizing and planning the Board’s 50th Anniversary and will provide a brief presentation at our April meeting.
 - The cannabis presentation has been rescheduled for Thursday, April 25 at St. Augustine Secondary School with thanks to A. Galvao. During the day, a group of students from the Mississauga Brampton Central Family of Schools will lead an Innovation Technology Day at St. Augustine and will also present during this parent engagement evening.
 - The evening will begin with a presentation on the Legalization of Cannabis and the impact it has on our schools. Peel Regional Police will be on site to answer questions as well.
 - i) Responding to K. Dancy, Superintendent W. Brunton will provide information regarding the cancelled Mississauga South Parent Engagement event at the next meeting.
3. OAPCE Report – M. Kutin Morais
 - Chair P. Olivieri welcomed M. Kutin Morais for joining the committee moving forward.
 - OAPCE had a Board of Directors meeting on February 8 and 9. Four members were elected which included Bishop Dabrowski from the London region.
 - The OAPCE 80th Conference will be a two-day event starting on Friday, April 5 at the Montecassino Hotel and Venue. A flyer was provided at the last meeting. There is a call for nominations for the Parent of the Year Award to be submitted by the end of March.
 - Recently met with the Honourable Lisa Thompson, Minister of Education, to emphasize the importance of Catholic education, the need to continue providing the parents with the PRO Grants and the need for support and collaboration.
