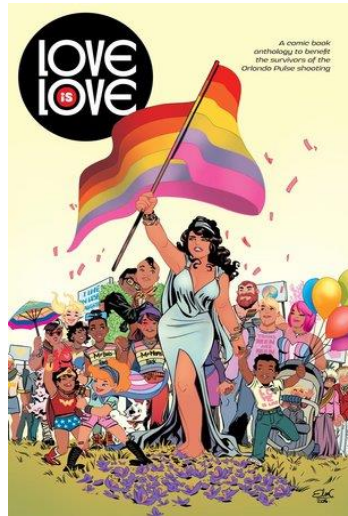
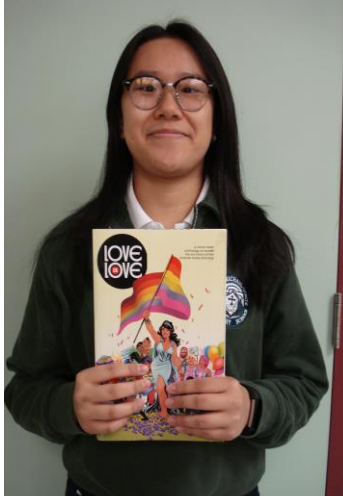


Love is Love, a Comic Book Anthology

The comic book anthology *Love is Love*, created by DC Publishing (including authors ranging from G. Willow Wilson to Jim Zub) will break your heart and mend it back again. This book was created for the victims of the “Orlando Pulse” shooting in Orlando, Florida that targeted the LGBT+ and Latin communities. The names of the forty-nine people who were killed in the mass shooting are honored in this book.

Love is Love made me cry and laugh all at the same time. The connections that these stories create are heartwarming and demonstrate that love will always be love, not matter who tries to stop it. The authors and illustrators show the sorrow in the hearts of the Orlando community but also show the strength that comes alongside it – the strength of love.
