Dear Parents/Guardians,

As part of the Grade 5 social studies curriculum, we have studied government. This topic connects to the IB Transdisciplinary theme of “How We Organize Ourselves”. With restrictions lifting, we now have the opportunity to offer a culminating experience for the Grade 5 students of a field trip to the Ontario Legislative Assembly. The Grade 5 class will be going on a trip to Queen’s Park for a guided tour on **Wednesday, June 15th, 2022**. We will be investigating the purpose and creation of governments, the connections between Canada’s three levels of government and the electoral process.

We will be leaving the school at 9:15 a.m. and returning by 12:00 p.m. The students will be returning to St. James to eat their lunch. Any medical conditions (i.e. asthma, anaphylaxis, bee stings) should be brought to the attention of the teacher prior to the trip.

As with all of our school trips, parent volunteers are very important. If you would like to be considered as a volunteer, please send a note to the classroom teacher in your child’s agenda. Only those that have a police check on file can be considered. Volunteers are taken on a first come, first served basis and **you will be notified by the teacher if you will be joining the trip.** We regret that younger siblings are not able to accompany us on the trip to Queen’s Park. This trip allows for 4 adult volunteers to attend.

The cost of the trip is **\$13.00 per student**. If you wish for your child to participate, payment is to be made **through the School Cash Online system.**
