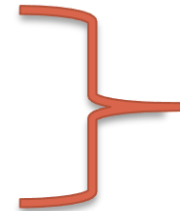

Academic Acknowledgement at Graduation



ONTARIO SCHOLAR

- Min. 80% overall average
- Calculation is based on your **top six grade 12** courses on your transcript (night/summer/elearn/private) ENG not a requirement
- OS recipients receive a **certificate** issued by the Ontario Ministry of Education

Program requirements

It is YOUR responsibility to make sure you have the courses required for entry into your program of choice!!

- ie. ENG4U1 and 5 additional grade 12 U/M
- ie. ENG4C1 and 3 additional C/M courses from grade 11 or 12

* these are only 2 examples!

- **DIPLOMA (2 YEAR PROGRAM)**
- **ADVANCED DIPLOMA (3 YEAR PROGRAM)**
- **APPLIED DEGREE (4 YEAR PROGRAM)**

✓ **September-December**- Research program options/pre-reqs. You can begin applying in late October.

✓ **February 1, 2025**

- Application deadline for equal consideration date*

✓ **May 1, 2025**- Deadline for confirming your acceptance

- You can apply to an apprenticeship/pre-apprenticeship program at a college or private colleges

- **BACHELOR DEGREE (3 YEAR PROGRAM)**
- **HONOURS BACHELOR DEGREE (4 YEAR PROGRAM)**

GRADUATE DEGREES

- **THESE VARY AND WILL DEPEND ON THE DEGREE
I.E. EDUCATION, LAW, MEDICINE**



Important Dates:

✓ **September-October- Research options/programs/pre-reqs**

✓ **January 15, 2025- You can apply beginning the end of October**

✓ **May 29, 2025- Latest date of notification of decision from the Universities**

✓ **June 2, 2025- The earliest date by which Ontario Universities may require a response to an offer of admission/financial commitment**



What you need to be considered:

✓ An OSSD

✓ 6 grade 12 U/M level courses

✓ Including ENG4U and any other program specific prerequisites



Application Fee:

\$ 156

√A non-refundable fee which allows for 3 program choices

√\$50- The cost of each additional university/program choice

√ \$ for supplementary applications (Engineering, Computer Science, etc)

√Maximum of 3 programs per university

*changing from one program to another at the same school = no charge. To change choice from one school to another = \$50

College & University

Marks/ Transcripts:

√All grade 11 & 12 final marks already on transcript

√Plus semester 1 mid-terms

√Decisions are most often based on 1st semester final, 2nd semester midterm (they will see 1st semester midterm)

***offers are conditional**

√A transcript of your marks to both OCAS and OUAC will be sent for you periodically throughout the year!!!
