

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN A MEMBERSHIP?

We offer youth drop-in programs Monday through Friday from 3 pm to 5 pm completely free of charge. Programs are either for youth 10-14 or 14-18 years of age. Activities may include:

- Sports (Basketball, Soccer, Floor Hockey, Volleyball, Badminton, etc)
- Hip Hop Dance/ Breakdancing Classes
- Access to "Youth Only" computers and staff tutors to assist with homework
- Foosball, Pool Tables, Ping Pong Tables, Switch Hockey and video games
- Special Events (Such as dances, pool parties, scavenger hunts etc)

It's just three easy steps!

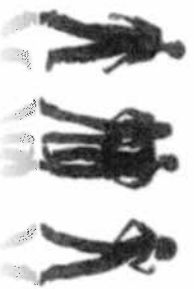
1. Complete both sides of the application form and have your parents sign it

YOUTH CODE OF CONDUCT

- At the first visit, participants must complete the Application Form and present a picture ID and proof of age in order to receive a Youth Drop-In Membership card at no cost.
- Each youth drop-in participant will scan their card prior to entering the program. If the card is lost or stolen, it is the participant's responsibility to purchase a new card from the Customer Service Desk at a cost of \$5.00 plus applicable taxes.
- All participants will respect all staff, participants and equipment. Any kind of threat towards staff or participants and/or the misuse of Community Centre property will not be tolerated and will result in the immediate ban from the facility.
- Swearing or inappropriate language will not be tolerated within the Community Centre and could result in a ban from youth programs or the Centre.
- No weapons of any sort will be permitted on City of Mississauga property. Anyone found concealing a weapon will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and banned from all City of Mississauga property.
- The participants using the equipment are responsible for ensuring all parts of the equipment are accounted for and properly stored when leaving the program.
- If facility staff suspect the use of alcohol or drugs upon sign-in, the participant will not be permitted into the Youth program. In some cases, Parents/Guardians will be contacted.

I, _____ understand that to participate in the youth program I agree to follow the youth conduct as outlined above. Consequences for breaking the Code of Conduct may include being banned from the youth program or any City of Mississauga property.

Terms and Conditions of Membership Pass

- Youth Memberships are valid at all participating City operated youth centres.
- All safety and administration/supervision guidelines are in effect (see staff for details).
- Loss of card is to be reported immediately. A replacement fee will be charged for replacing lost cards.
- Membership/ Passes are non-transferable.
- To gain admittance to any included Youth Drop In activities, please present the card to staff and use the card scanner.
- I agree to have my picture taken for my recreation pass card.
- I agree to abide by all facility rules and regulations and understand that my failure to do so may result in suspension of membership/pass or admittance privileges.

Health Declaration

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I have no knowledge of any [physical disability which would make participation in the Community Centre hazardous to my health under this membership/pass (otherwise, medical certificate MUST be submitted). I understand that certain risks of injury may occur while participating in all sports, recreational activities, programs and services, such as muscle stiffness, sprains, strains, nausea, light headedness, chest pain and other health risks. I understand that certain recreational activities require a minimum level of fitness and health (physical, emotional and mental) and that all individuals vary in their capacity to participate. Therefore, I consider myself physically able to participate and by continuing my participation, I will assume those risks and results which may be associated with these activities.

Medical Authorization

On behalf of yourself and the participants you register for whom in law you are responsible for, you hereby give permission to have staff administer or arrange for any emergency medical care including hospitalization/ transportation, if necessary, and you hereby consent on behalf of yourself and the participant(s) you register to the administration of such emergency medical treatments, as may be deemed necessary in the circumstances. All participants are responsible for their own medical coverage.

Waiver of Liability

I agree to release and waive all claims and hereby indemnify and hold harmless the Corporation of the City of Mississauga ("City"), its volunteers and other participants for any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury resulting to me or to any of the above-named person(s) for whom I am in law responsible, from or connected with participation in any activity contemplated by this Registration. I hereby further agree that the City, its volunteers and other participants shall not be liable, either directly or indirectly, for any claims, or any damages, costs and expenses respecting any act done in good faith, including but not limited to personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from or connected with participation in any activity contemplated by this Registration, whether or not such injury, damage or loss resulting from or connected with participation in any activity contemplated by this Registration, whether or not such injury, damage or loss occurred as result of any negligence, negligent misrepresentation or breach of statutory duty and/or breach of contract on the part of the City, its volunteers and other participants, unless the damages are the result of gross negligence on the part of the City, its volunteers and other participants.

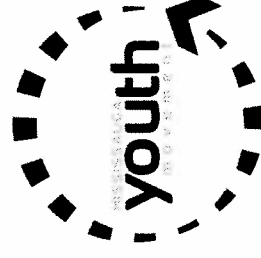
