- 1. The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) supports offering a compulsory day retreat for all secondary school students.
- 2. Each year, all DPCDSB secondary schools shall offer a compulsory day retreat for all students.
- 3. All secondary school retreats shall follow models approved by system and school-based leadership.
- 4. Secondary students may be charged a consistent annual fee, as per <u>GAP2005</u>, for faith formation initiatives, which will include an annual dayretreat.
- 5. Every secondary school shall include a statement in their course calendar and in their student handbook/agenda, clearly indicating the compulsory nature of faith development in a Catholic school.
