The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board shall establish a 'Supervised Alternative Learning' (SAL) Committee to consider applications from students for supervised alternative learning who are not otherwise excused under section 21 of the *Education Act*. The Supervised Alternative Learning Committee, as laid out in Ontario Regulation 374/10, "Supervised Alternative Learning and Other Excusals from Attendance at School" enables the board to excuse students, from fourteen to seventeen years of age, from attending school while they continue to participate in learning under the supervision of the board and/or a school of the board.
