- Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) school principals are responsible for maintaining proper order and discipline in their schools. Students are responsible to the principal for their conduct.
- 2. A principal may delegate certain disciplinary responsibilities to a vice principal and/or teacher at the school in accordance with this Policy and *General Administrative Procedure (GAP) GAP2015*Delegation of Authority by the Principal (GAP2015), which set out the requirements for delegation.
- 3. **References** relevant to this policy include:
 - a) Section 265(1)(a) of the *Education Act*, and sections 11(1) and 23(4) of *Ontario Regulation 298 Operation of Schools*, provide that principals are required to maintain proper order and discipline in schools, and pupils are responsible to the principal for their conduct.
 - b) Section 300.1 of the *Education Act* provides the authority for a principal to delegate powers, duties or functions under Part XIII of the *Education Act* Behaviour, Discipline and Safety, to a vice-principal of the school or to a teacher employed in the school as per Ministry of Education policy.
 - c) Section 302(0.1) of the *Education Act* requires boards to establish policies addressing delegation of authority by principals.
 - d) The Ministry of Education's Policy/Program Memorandum No. 145 (PPM 145) sets out the requirements for a policy regarding delegation of authority.
