Land Acknowledgement

We begin by acknowledging the land and our responsibility to care for and respect all that Creation gives to provide us with life. This land upon which we live, work and sustain ourselves is the ancestral and treaty lands of the Michizaagiig Anishinaabek also known today as the Mississaugas of the Credit, the rightful caretakers and titleholders of this land. We also recognize that this land is rich in pre-contact history and relationships, which includes the Anishinaabek and Onkwehonwe and since European contact has and continues to become home for Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples.



Land Acknowledgement

Colonialism displaced and dispossessed Indigenous Peoples of their ancestral lands and continues to deny their basic human rights, dignities and freedoms. Why are students being relocated?

- Ministry has approved our capital project to rebuild St. Anne
- >Existing building will be demolished
- ➤ Safety of staff and students
- Size and configuration of the site is not suitable to build the school on another part of the site while the school remains operational
- ➤Insufficient access of construction vehicles and storage of materials, lack of parking for staff, no play space for students

St. Anne Enrolment

- Current Enrolment: 486 students
- > 10 students in remote classes

Extended French	143	6

Options Considered

- Relocate entire school to a closed elementary school in Central Mississauga
- Host school by program
 - > regular track at one location and extended French at another location
- Host school by grade
 - > FDK to grade 3 at one location and grade 4 to 8 at another location

Option Considerations

- Available classroom space
- Available kindergarten space
- Proximity to St. Anne
- > Kiss 'n ride to accommodate additional busses

St. Anne will continue to operate as St. Anne CES, with their own staff, teachers, and administration and separate start/end times from the host school

Regular Track students K- Gr.8

Hosted at St. Ursula CES

Extended French students Gr.5 – Gr.8

> Hosted at St. Angela Merici CES

Remote Students will not be affected

St. Ursula:


- Available classrooms = 15

New kiss'n ride and parking area




Site Plan






