## How to Register — PEEL, Private School & Other School Board Students

#### **Registration Process**

All students wishing to take a night school course:

- must FULLY complete the registration form
- must forward their completed registration form to their Guidance Counsellor for review and approval (current Secondary Day School Students only)
- Registration forms will be processed only after Guidance Counsellor approval is received
- 📤 September 16, 2025 @ 12:00 noon: Deadline for all approved registration forms

#### **Cancellation of Courses**

- Courses run pending enrolment
- 🧆 In certain circumstances (low enrollment) course delivery may change (in-person to online synchronous or online synchronous to in-person)
- Students will receive calls/emails only if the course has been cancelled or course delivery mode has changed
- Individual student confirmations are not sent out
- Students are strongly advised to check with their Guidance Counsellor for course cancellation or availability

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ**

**Delivery of Courses**: Courses will be delivered in person or online synchronous.

Attendance: Regular attendance is crucial for success in all Night School credit programs. Attendance and punctuality are compulsory. Students must participate on the first day of Night School or will be withdrawn from the course. Students will be demitted after 3 (three) consecutive absences. Students may be demitted following a contravention of the Catholic Code of Conduct.

#### Final Assessment:

Students must write/complete their final assessment at the end of the program, on the date and time set out by the Adult and Continuing Education Department. Students who miss the scheduled final assessment will receive a mark of zero for the assessment.

Textbooks: Students must provide their own textbook. Textbook information will be provided to students on the first night of classes.

Reports: An interim report will be issued mid-way through the course. All students MUST write or complete their FINAL Assessment.

<u>Safe Schools</u>: The DPCDSB Safe Schools Policy is posted at http://www.dpcdsb.org follow the link to Safe Schools. Students whose behaviour impacts the safety or learning of other students will be withdrawn.

Registration Criteria for Day Students: The student has the required prerequisite and the Principal/Designate has approved the application. Students must be at least 16 years of age and have completed grade 10.

<u>Dress Code</u>: Students are expected to dress in a respectful manner which ensures that the top of the shoulders to mid-thigh are not exposed. A policy statement regarding expectations will be shared the first evening of credit Night School by the school administration.

International Fee-Paying Students: Students on a Visa Permit must contact the Adult and Continuing Education office at 905-362-0701 EXT. 50016 for further directions prior to applying through their Guidance office. Letters of authorization and fees must be obtained prior to Night School commencing.

<u>Special Education:</u> Students who may require accommodations are advised to consult with their Guidance Counsellor regarding Night School expectations and recommendations.

<u>Medical Concerns:</u> Participants in Adult and Continuing Education Programs must advise the administration and classroom teacher of any major health concerns/conditions/ anaphylactic allergies and ensure an emergency contact number is available.
