B. Presentations and Staff Reports

1. Program Updates: A. Lawrence

Superintendent Papaloni introduced Alexandra Lawrence, Coordinator, Special Education, to update the committee on Special Education programs. A. Lawrence discussed the reorganization of the IDEA program site locations to ensure balanced support for all schools. Superintendent Papaloni mentioned that this change is due to the reorganization of the Family of Schools.

2. Puratos: L. Pincente

Superintendent Papaloni introduced L. Pincente, Coordinator, Special Education, to present the Puratos project. L. Pincente announced the new partnership between Puratos Canada and Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board. This collaboration blends skills development with academics, promising hands-on experience for students. Puratos Bakery School foundation spans the world with bakery schools and is a charitable foundation. Dufferin-Peel will be the very first Puratos Bakery school in Canada. This will provide students with job opportunities in the future. K. Boily, Consultant, Special Education, continued the presentation with information on objectives with this initiative. She mentioned that Father Michael Goetz CSS will be the host site for this pilot. She explained the process for students to apply to and be considered for this program. The project started in mid-2024, and the first program will start semester 2, February 2026. The first criteria to qualify is a love of baking. There will be 25 spots available to start. Students with special needs will also be able to participate.

3. Parent Reaching Out Grant Updates: T. Abbruscato

Superintendent Papaloni introduced T. Abbruscato, Consultant, Special Education, to provide updates for the Parent Reaching Out Event Employment Supports Resource Fair. The event was held on Wednesday, May 28th at St. Marcellinus CSS. The event provided opportunities for students and families to receive information on employment supports planning.

Trustee Bruno lannicca discussed the Prom Night event which he attended on May 30th. The students had the opportunity to dance and enjoy a fun evening with peers. There was a quiet room to accommodate anyone in need of a break.
