## BACKGROUND

The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) revised policy *P-8007 Flag Protocol*. This report summarizes updates made to P-8007.

## DISCUSSION

On September 23, 2025, the Ministry of Education directed the Ministry-appointed Supervisor to amend *P-8007 Flag Protocol* to require the display of the Survivor’s Flag or Every Child Matters Flag on September 30<sup>th</sup> of each year in honour of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. P-8007 has been amended as requested.

## CONCLUSION


At the direction of the Ministry-appointed Supervisor, DPCDSB staff revised *P-8007 Flag Protocol*.
